2022 HARVEST

The slate soil of San Vitorio vineyard, on the banks of the Miño river, leads this wine towards spices, black fruits and liquorice. The schist soil in the plots of the Sil and Bibei river accompany the rest of its journey with red fruits and flowers.

- D. O. Ribeira Sacra.
- Atlantic climate with continental influence.
- 100% Mencia grape.
- Grape destemmed and crushed, fermentation for 10 days with gentle pumping, followed by a maceration during 8 days.
- Aged in French oak barrels of second and third use for 4 months.
